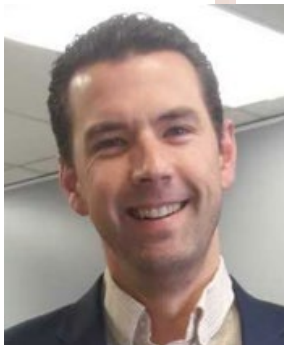


Session C: Getting Back Into The Swing of Things: Engaging Post Pandemic FCC Learners
